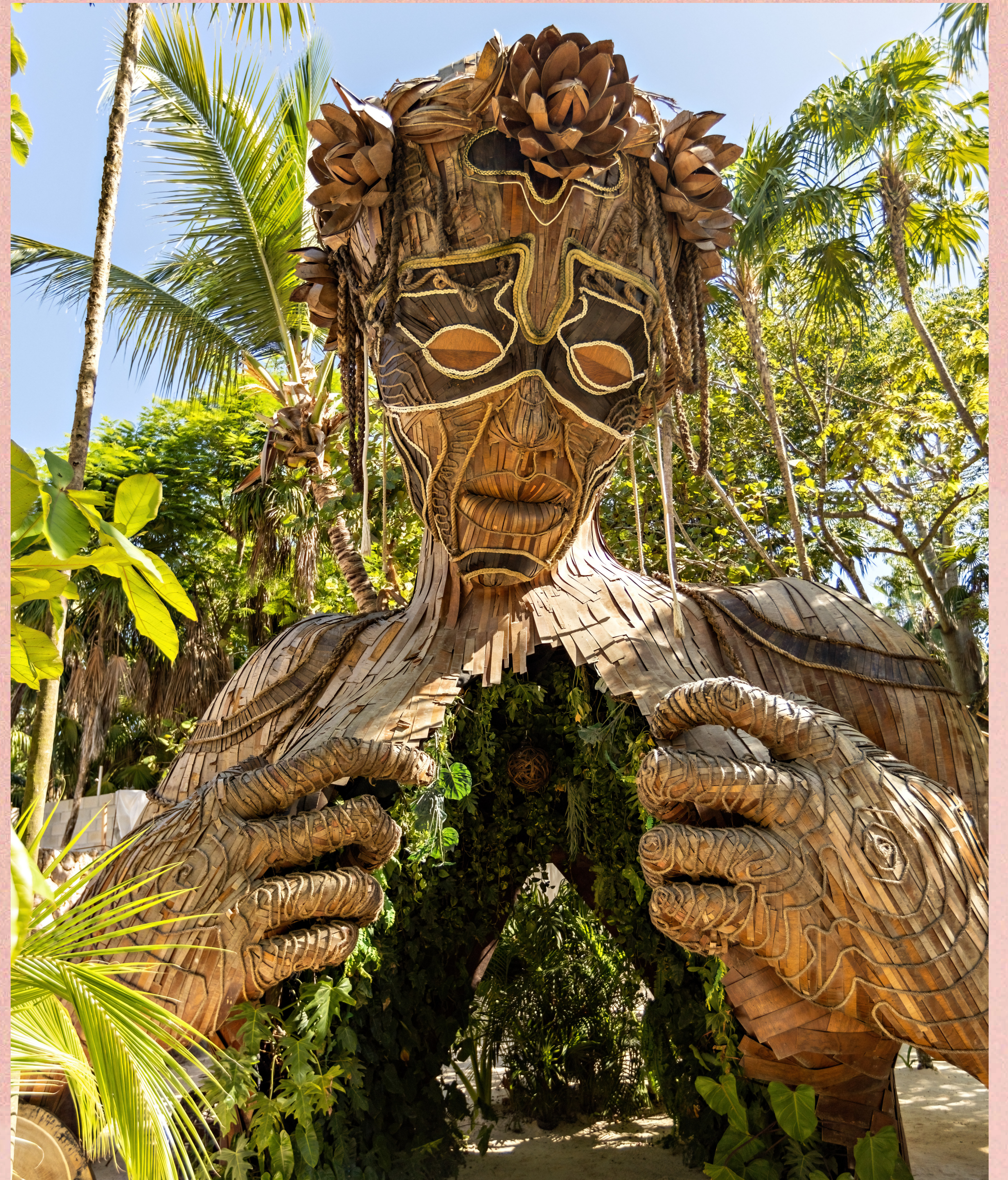
# Tulum

## Kaan Luum

Kaan Luum Lagoons is one of Tulum's hidden natural treasures, known for its striking contrast between shallow turquoise waters and the deep cenote located at its center. Surrounded by jungle and peaceful landscapes, it offers a calm atmosphere perfect for swimming, relaxing and reconnecting with nature away from the crowds.



## Yal-Ku

Laguna Yal-Ku is a beautiful natural inlet where freshwater and saltwater meet, creating crystal-clear waters filled with colorful marine life. Surrounded by mangroves and tropical vegetation, it is an ideal place for snorkeling, floating and enjoying the quiet beauty of the Riviera Maya.



## Nopalitos

Hidden within the mangroves, Laguna Nopalitos stands out for its emerald-green waters and untouched natural surroundings. Its peaceful atmosphere and unique ecosystem make it a perfect escape for those looking to experience a quieter and more authentic side of Tulum and the Riviera Maya.



## *Cenotes*

Tulum is known to have the world's largest number of underwater sink holes, or cenotes. Formed when limestone is gradually eroded over hundred of years, are an excellent place to swim, snorkel, or dive.

# *Sian Kaan Muyil*

The ancient Mayan ruins of Muyil, in the center of the Sian Kaan Reserve, seem taken from an ancient film. While touring the ruins, you will discover the incredible history of this ancient civilization. Muyil was one of the first Mayan enclaves on the east coast of the Yucatan Peninsula.

During the tour, you will walk through this inspiring ecological reserve and enjoy breathtaking views of the virgin jungle inhabited by hundreds of species of birds, plants, and animals.

After the walk, you will enjoy a boat trip through the ancient Mayan canals and visit the Xlapak temple, where you can admire the details of these remarkably preserved ruins. You will then continue navigating through the mangroves and crystal-clear waters surrounding the peninsula.

On the boat, you can enjoy Mexican snacks while taking in the beautiful scenery. This tour offers a perfect combination of culture, nature, and relaxation.
